The conference does not specialize on a given topic or geographical area but it emphasizes empirical rigor and innovation, as well as the ability to meet the challenges of interdisciplinary audiences. Submissions are particularly welcome on topics concerning: population, families and the welfare state; population and economic development/institutions; finance and population issues.

Alp-Pop emphasizes the importance of both formal and informal social interaction among scholars, favoring such interaction by combining a traditional conference program with joint activities in a world-class winter resort. The conference location, the Planibel Hotel, is directly located on the well-known ski slopes of La Thuile.

Submissions of original papers or extended abstracts (about 4 pages) are invited by **October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010** at latest. Decisions about acceptance for presentation in the conference will be communicated by November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 at latest.
